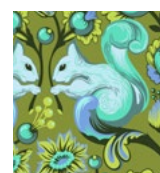
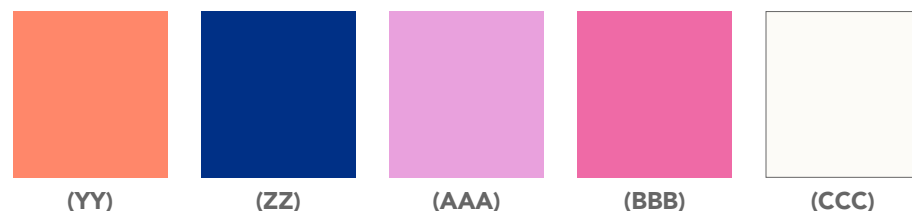

Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric, HST= Half-square Triangle, QST= Quarter-square Triangle
Fussy-cut squares have the motif centered in the square. Note: You will have some leftover pieces for another project.

Fabric A, cut:

- (1) 17⁷/₈" x WOF (45.40cm x WOF); sub-cut (2) 17⁷/₈" (45.40cm) squares, cut diagonally into (4) HST
- (1) 29⁵/₈" (75.25cm) square, cut twice diagonally into (4) QST
- (1) 8¹/₂" (21.59cm) square, fussy-cut on point

Fabric B, cut:

- (1) 17⁷/₈" (45.40cm) square; cut once diagonally into (2) HST
- (1) 29⁵/₈" (75.25cm) square, cut twice diagonally into (4) QST
- (1) 4⁷/₈" x WOF (12.38cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4⁷/₈" (12.38cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (8) HST
- (10) 2¹/₄" x WOF (5.72cm x WOF), for binding

Fabrics C- I, W, X, Y, Z, and AA, cut from each:

- (1) 8¹/₂" (21.59cm) square, fussy-cut on point

Fabrics J-U, cut from each:

- (2) 3" x WOF (7.62cm x WOF); sub-cut (3) 3" x 16¹/₂" (7.62cm x 41.91cm)

Fabric V, cut:

- (24) 4¹/₂" (11.43cm) square, fussy-cut on point

Fabrics BB-JJ, and LL, cut from each:

- (1) 4⁷/₈" x WOF (12.38cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 4⁷/₈" (12.38cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (8) HST

Fabric KK, cut:

- (1) 4⁷/₈" x WOF (12.38cm x WOF); sub-cut (8) 4⁷/₈" (12.38cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (16) HST

Fabrics MM, NN, RR, SS, TT, VV, WW, XX, ZZ, and BBB cut from each:

- (1) 1¹/₂" x WOF (3.81cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 1¹/₂" (3.81cm) squares
- (1) 3³/₄" x WOF (9.53cm x WOF); sub-cut (2) 3³/₄" (9.53cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (4) HST; (1) 3¹/₄" x WOF (8.26cm x WOF); sub-cut (5) 3¹/₄" (8.26cm) squares, cut twice diagonally into (20) QST; and (4) 2⁷/₈" (7.30cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (8) HST
- (1) 2¹/₂" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub-cut (4) 2¹/₂" (6.35cm) squares and (4) 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" (3.81cm x 6.35cm)
- (2) 1⁷/₈" x WOF (4.76cm x WOF); sub-cut (28) 1⁷/₈" (4.76cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (56) HST

Fabric PP, YY, and AAA, cut from each:

- (1) 1¹/₂" x WOF (3.81cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 1¹/₂" (3.81cm) squares
- (1) 3³/₄" x WOF (9.53cm x WOF); sub-cut (2) 3³/₄" (9.53cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (4) HST; (5) 3¹/₄" (8.26cm) squares, cut twice diagonally into (20) QST; (4) 2⁷/₈" (7.30cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (8) HST ; cut (4) 1 7/8" (4.76cm) squares, cut once diagonally into (8) HST

Fabric OO, QQ, and UU, cut from each:

- (1) 2¹/₂" x WOF (6.35cm x WOF); sub- cut (4) 2¹/₂" (6.35cm) squares, (4) 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" (3.81cm x 6.35cm)
- (2) 1⁷/₈" x WOF (4.76cm x WOF); sub-cut (24) 1⁷/₈" (4.76) squares, cut once diagonally into (48) HST

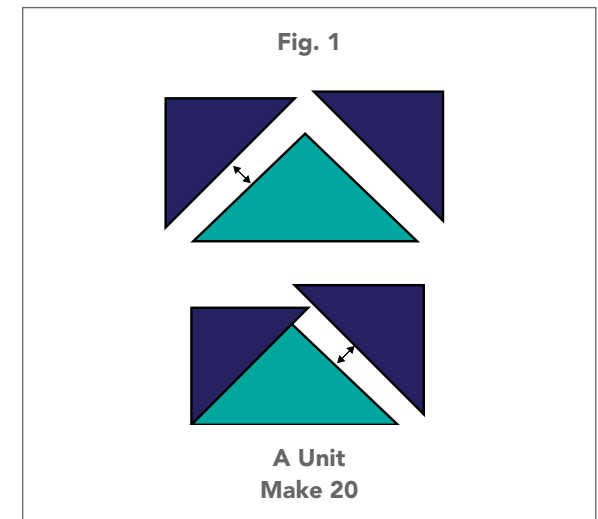
Fabric CCC, cut:

- (36) 1¹/₄" x WOF (3.17cm x WOF); sub-cut (72) 1¹/₄" x 16¹/₂" (3.17cm x 41.91cm)

Sewing

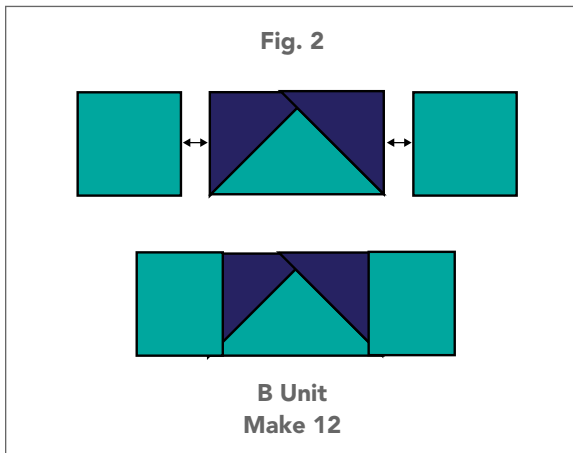
All seam allowances are 1/4" (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press all seams as indicated.

1. Sew (1) 1¹/₄" x 16¹/₂" (3.17cm x 41.91cm) **Fabric CCC** to each side of the 3" x 16¹/₂" (7.62cm x 41.91cm) **Fabrics J-U** strips. Press seams toward **Fabrics J-U**, trim and square to 4¹/₂" x 16¹/₂" (11.43cm x 41.91cm). Set aside as the Sashing Strips.
2. Using the chart on page 6 for the fabric pairings, sew (1) 1⁷/₈" (4.76cm) HST to each side of the 3¹/₄" (8.26cm) QST to make (20) A Units of each. These pairings will be the same for the remaining construction steps (**Fig. 1**).

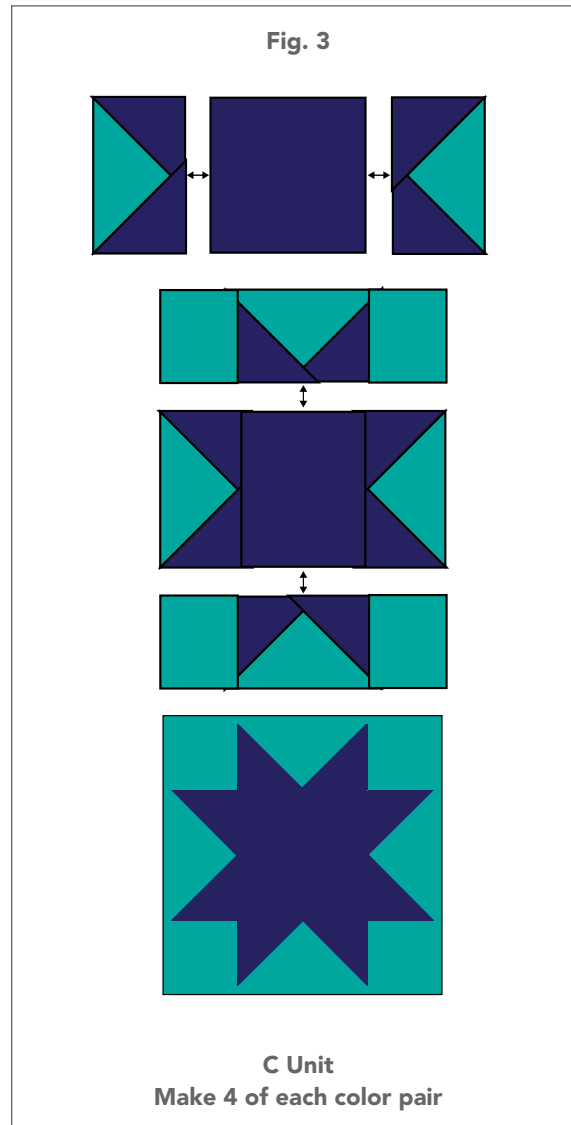

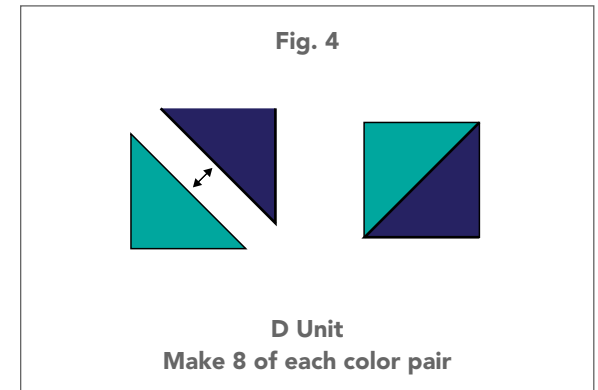
3. Sew (1) 1½" (3.81cm) square to (12) A Units, matching the background color of the A Unit. Press seams open. Make (12) B Units of each pairing (Fig. 2).



4. Sew (2) A units, (2) B Units, and (1) 2½" (6.35cm) square together, matching the color pairings, to make a C Unit. Make (4) C Units of each color pairing (Fig. 3). Press the seams open.



5. Using the same pairing chart above, sew (2) 1⅞" (4.76cm) HST together to make a D Unit. Make (8) D Units per color pairing (Fig. 4). Press the seams open.



6. Sew (2) D Units, (1) B Unit, and (1) 1½" x 2½" (3.81cm x 6.35cm) rectangle together, matching the color pairings (Fig. 5 on page 7). Press seams open.
7. Sew (1) 2⅞" (7.30cm) HST to each side and (1) 3¾" (9.53cm) HST to the top of the Step 6 unit, matching the background color and pressing the seams open after each seam to make an E Unit. Make (4) E Units per color pairing (Fig. 6 on page 7).

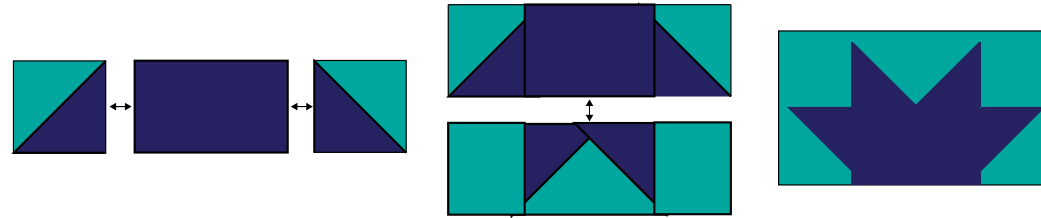
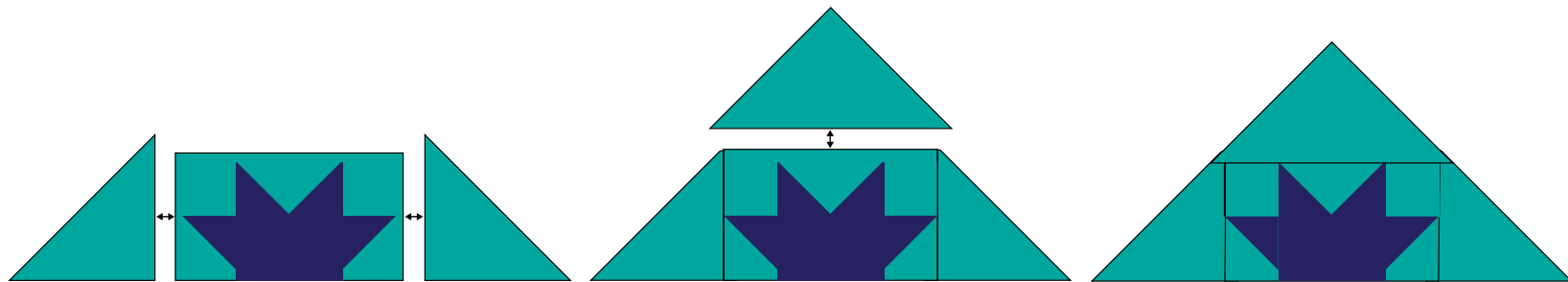

8. Using the chart below for fabric pairings, sew (4) C Units, (4) D Units, (8) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " (12.38cm) HST, and (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (21.59cm) square together to create a Star block. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Make a total of (13) Star Blocks. The color listed for the C/D units refers to the background of each unit. Trim each block to 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (41.91cm) square (**Fig. 7** on page 9).

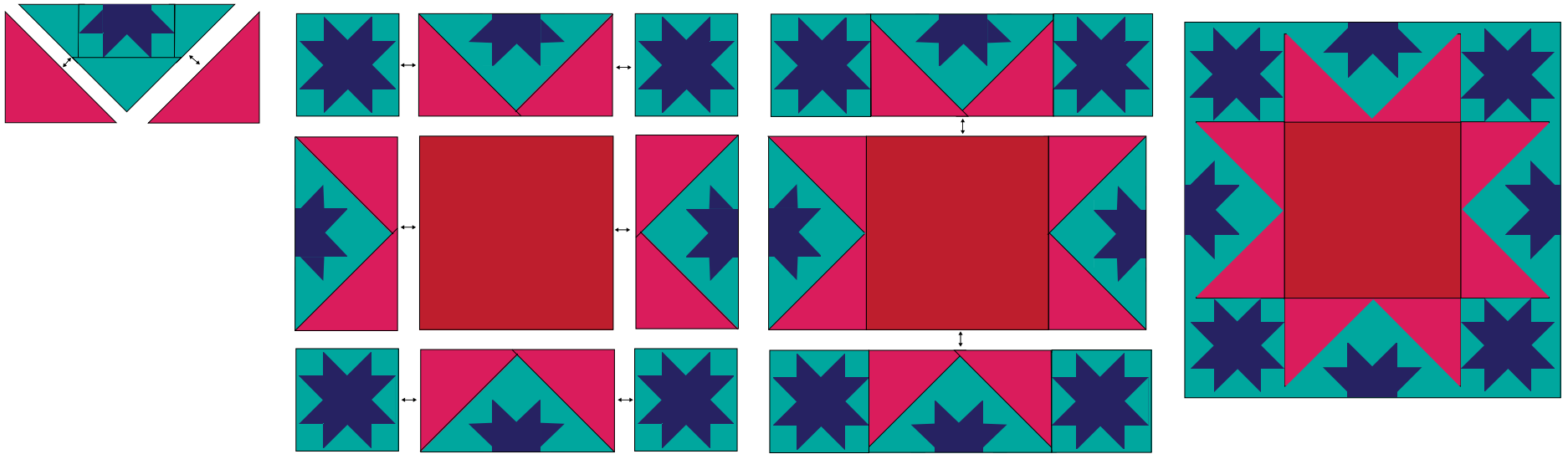
Quilt Top Assembly

9. Following the **Quilt Layout** on page 10, sew the **Fabric A** HST, **Fabric A** QST, **Fabric B** HST, **Fabric B** QST, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (11.43cm) **Fabric V** squares, Sashing Strips, and Star Blocks together into diagonal rows. Pay careful attention to the direction of each piece in the layout, making sure that the fussy-cut squares for each Star Block and **Fabric V** are have the same orientation. Star Blocks are referenced by the motif fabric. Press the seams in alternate directions for adjacent rows.
10. Sew the diagonal rows together in order, matching adjacent seams, to complete the quilt top. Press the seams towards the bottom of the quilt.

Finishing

11. Sew together the (10) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF (5.72cm x WOF) **Fabric B** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
12. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
13. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
14. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
