- Coats Dual Duty XP® All-purpose thread in coordinating colors
- 68" x 68" (172.72cm x 172.72cm) batting
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter/mat/ruler
- Plastic template material
- Basic sewing and pressing supplies

Cutting

Fabrics A and B, cut from each:

(1) 6" x WOF (15.24cm x WOF) strip;
sub-cut (16) Piece 2

Fabrics C and D, cut from each:

(5) 6" x WOF (15.24cm x WOF);
sub-cut (4) 6" x 16⁷/₈" (15.24cm x 42.86cm), (4) 6" x 11³/₈" (15.24cm x 28.89cm), and (4) 6" (15.24cm) squares

Fabric E, cut:

(1) 5¹/₈" x WOF (13.02cm x WOF);
sub-cut (8) 5¹/₈" (13.02cm) squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.

Fabrics F and G, fussy-cut from each:

(6) 6" (15.24cm) squares, (2) of each animal

Fabrics I and H, cut from each:

(2) 6¹/₄" x WOF (15.87cm x WOF);
sub-cut (8) 6¹/₄" (15.88cm) squares
(1) 5¹/₈" x WOF (13.02cm x WOF);
sub-cut (2) 5¹/₈" (13.02cm) squares

Fabric J, cut:

(1) 6" x WOF (15.24cm x WOF);
sub-cut (4) 6" (15.24cm) squares
(1) 5¹/₈" x WOF (13.02cm x WOF);
sub-cut (2) 5¹/₈" (13.02cm) squares

Fabrics K, cut:

(1) 6" x WOF (15.24cm x WOF);
sub-cut lengthwise (8) Piece 1, (4) with the deer up and (4) with the deer down (see **Quilt Layout**)

Fabric L, cut:

(2) 6" x WOF;
sub-cut crosswise (4) Piece 1 deer left facing and (4) Piece 1, with deer right facing (see **Quilt Layout**)

Fabric M, cut:

(2) 6¹/₄" x WOF (15.87cm x WOF);
sub-cut (8) 6¹/₄" (15.88cm) squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.
(1) 5¹/₈" x WOF (13.02cm x WOF);
sub-cut (2) 5¹/₈" (13.02cm) squares

Fabric N, cut:

(2) 6¹/₄" x WOF (15.87cm x WOF);
sub-cut (8) 6¹/₄" (15.88cm) squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.

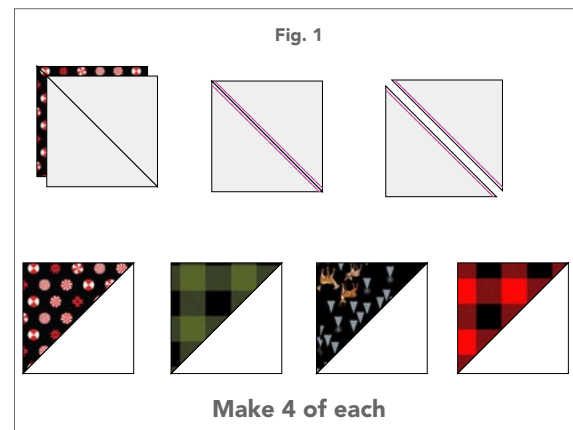
Fabric O, cut:

2¹/₂" (6.35cm) bias strips to make 250" (635cm) finished binding

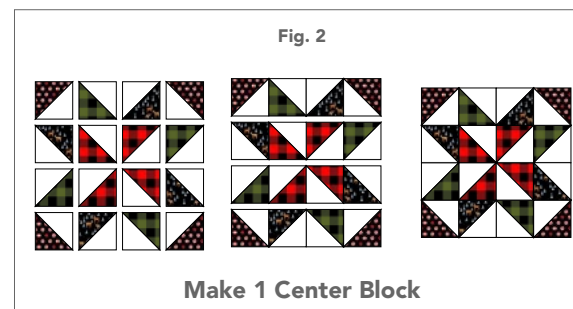
Sewing

All seam allowances are ¹/₄" (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Place a 5¹/₈" (13.02cm) **Fabric E** square right sides together with each of 5¹/₈" (13.02cm) **Fabric H, I, J, and M** squares. Sew ¹/₄" (.64cm) on each side of the marked line. Cut the unit in half on the original drawn line to create (2) half-square triangle units (HST) (**Fig. 1**). Make (4) of each fabric pair.



2. Noting the orientation of the one-way print, arrange the HST into (4) rows of (4) units each. Sew the blocks together in each row, then sew the rows together, matching adjacent seams, to complete the Center Block (**Fig. 2**).

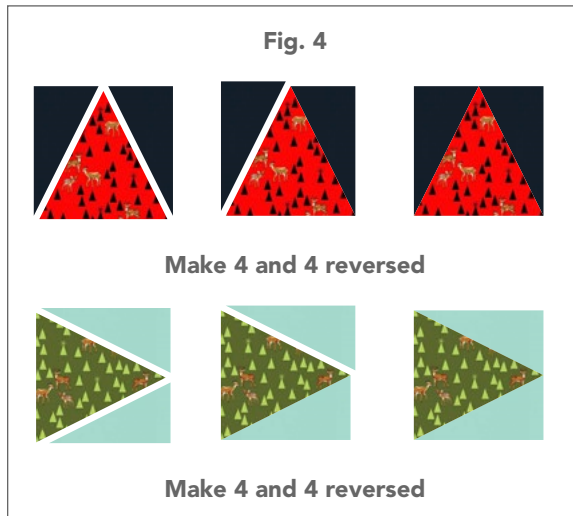


3. Place a 6¹/₄" (15.87cm) **Fabric N** square right sides together with a 6¹/₄" (15.88cm) **Fabric I** square. Sew ¹/₄" (.64cm) on each side of the marked line. Cut the unit in half on the original drawn line to create (2) half-square triangle units (HST). Make a total of (16).

4. Repeat Step 3 with the 6¼" (15.88cm) **Fabric M** and **Fabric H** squares. Make a total of (16) (**Fig. 3**).



5. Sew (1) **Fabric B** Piece 2 to each side of (1) **Fabric K** Piece 1. Make a total of (8) units—(4) of each direction.
6. Sew (1) **Fabric A** Piece 2 to each side of (1) **Fabric L** Piece 1. Make a total of (8) units—(4) of each direction (**Fig. 4**).



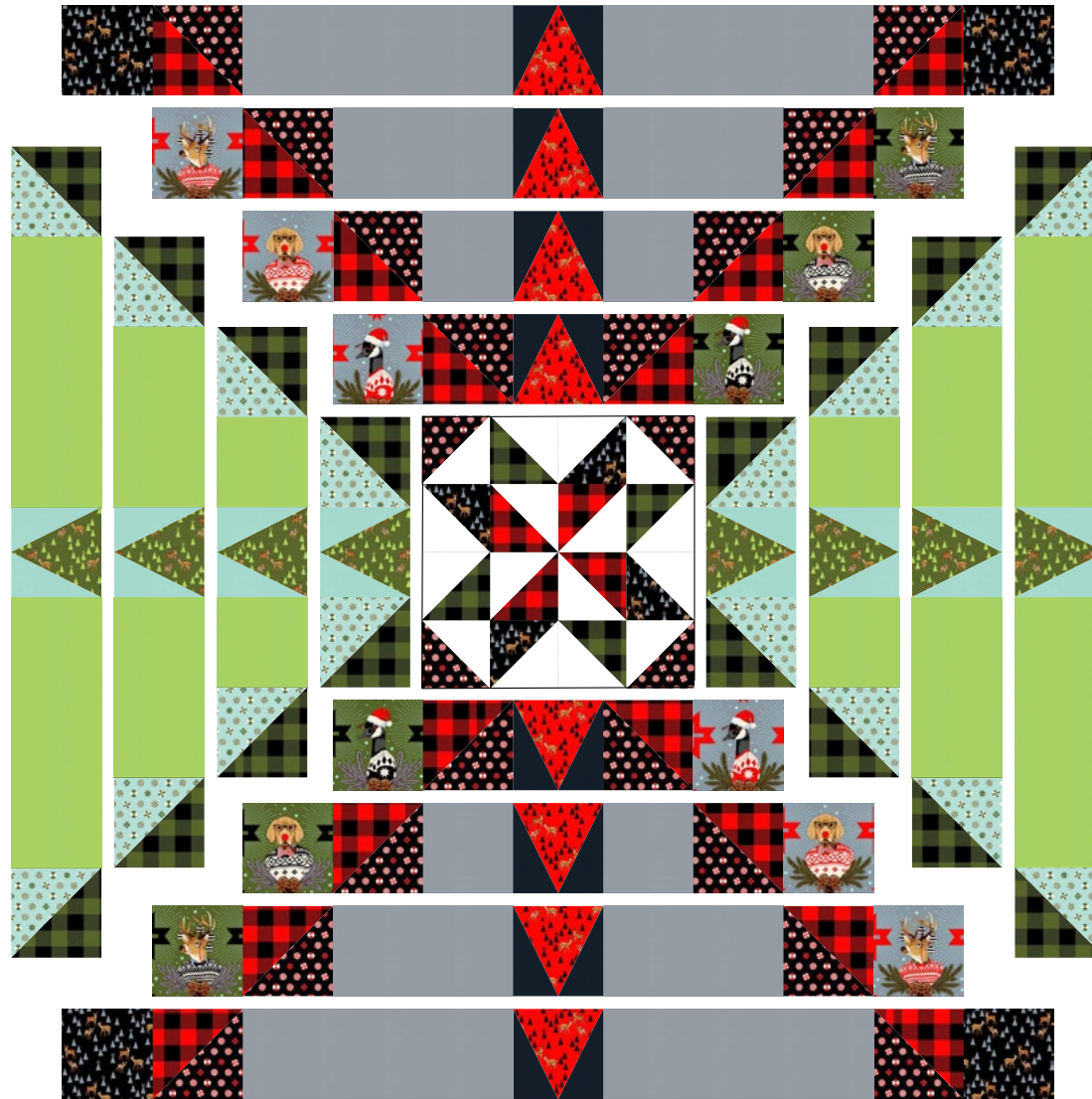
Quilt Top Assembly

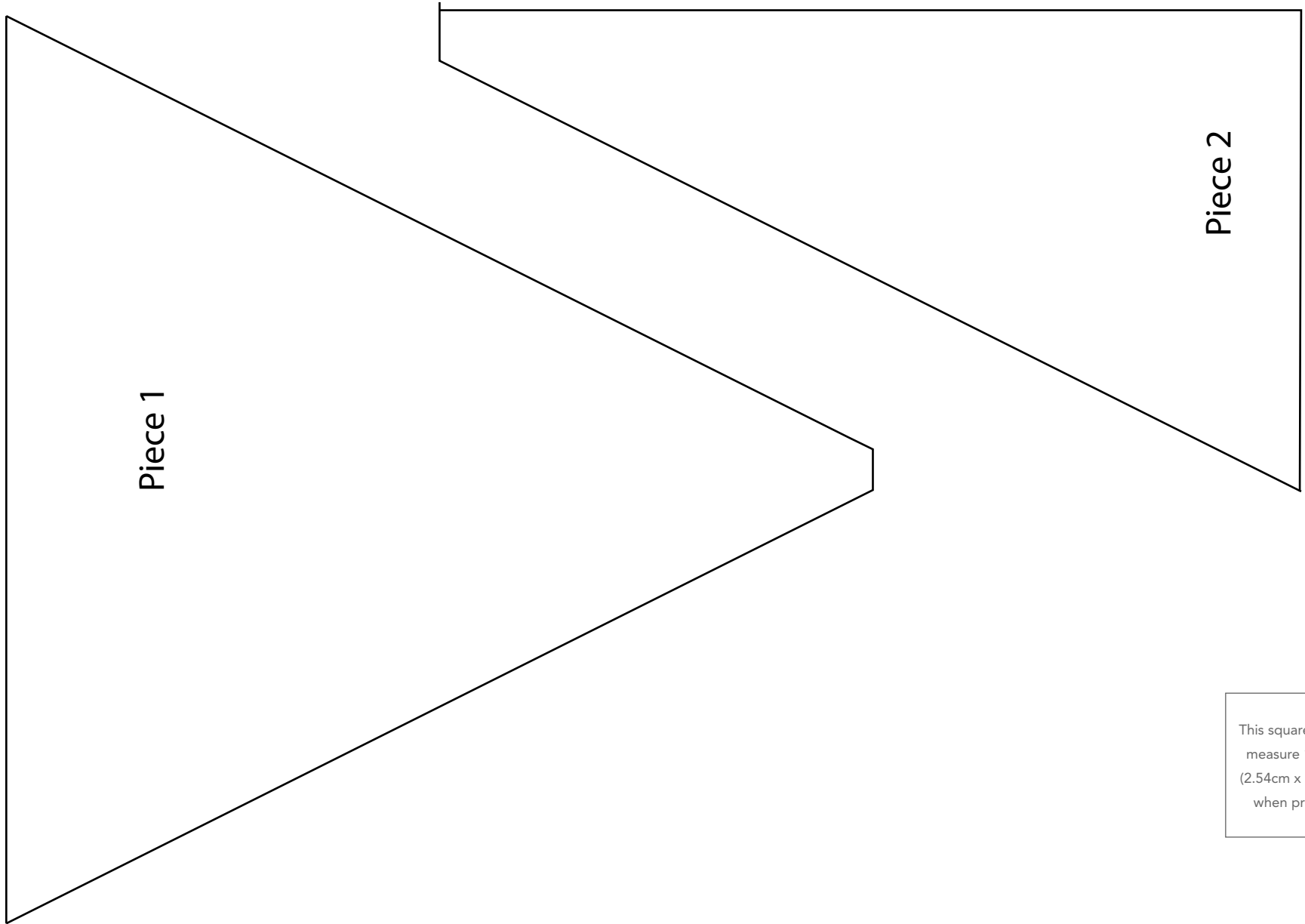
7. Follow the **Quilt Layout** diagram on page 5 to lay out the center block with the units created above and the **Fabrics C** and **D** rectangles.
8. Noting the orientation, add (1) unit to each side of the center block, then to the top and bottom. Continue working outward in this manner, matching adjacent seams, to complete the quilt top.

Finishing

9. Sew together the 2½" (6.35cm) bias **Fabric O** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
10. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
11. Leaving an 8" (20.32cm) tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" (30.48cm) from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" (.64cm) and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
12. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
