



# Shoreline

FEATURING SALT *Water* BY Tula PINK™

Finished Size: approx. 60" x 88"

### SHOPPING LIST:

- (30) 2½" x width of fabric strips  
or one Salt Water Design Roll
- (30) 5" squares  
or one Salt Water Charm Pack
- 2½" yards Background Fabric  
Free Spirit Designer Solid S100 Manatee
- Binding: ⅝ yard
- Backing: 5½ yards



### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. From each 2½" strip cut two 2½" x 10½" rectangles and one 2½" x 20½" rectangle. Keep each set of like fabric rectangles together.
2. Cut each 5" square in half to create two 2½" x 5" rectangles.
3. From your background fabric begin by trimming the width of the fabric down to 40".
4. From the background fabric that you trimmed in step three cut thirty strips that measure 2½" x 40".

### BUILDING THE STRIP SETS:

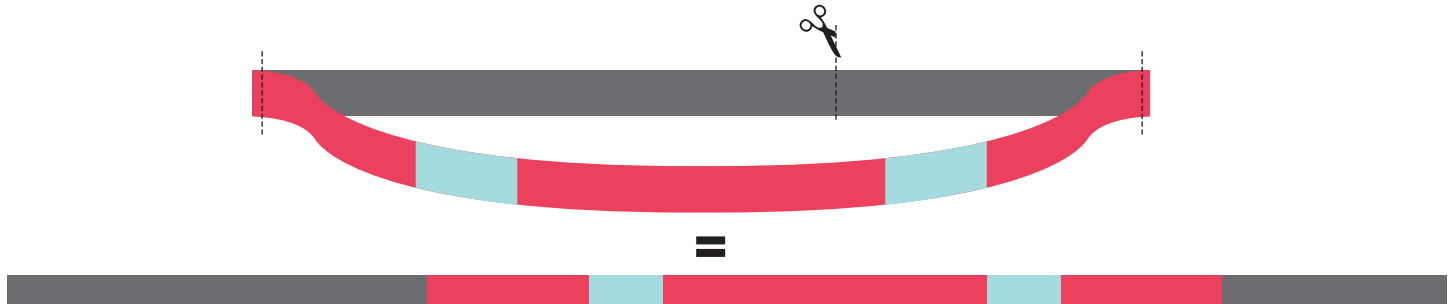
1. Select one set of strip rectangles and one set of charm rectangles.
2. Sew one 2½" x 10½" rectangle to one 2½" x 5" charm rectangle.
3. Sew one 2½" x 20" to the unit made in step two.
4. Sew the other 2½" x 5" charm rectangle to the unit made in step three.
5. Sew the last 2½" x 10½" rectangle to the unit completed in step four.



6. Repeat steps one through five to create a total of 30 strip sets.
7. Sew the short end of one background 2½" x 40" rectangle to one end of a strip set.
8. Sew the raw end of your background rectangle to the raw end of the strip set creating a fabric tube.



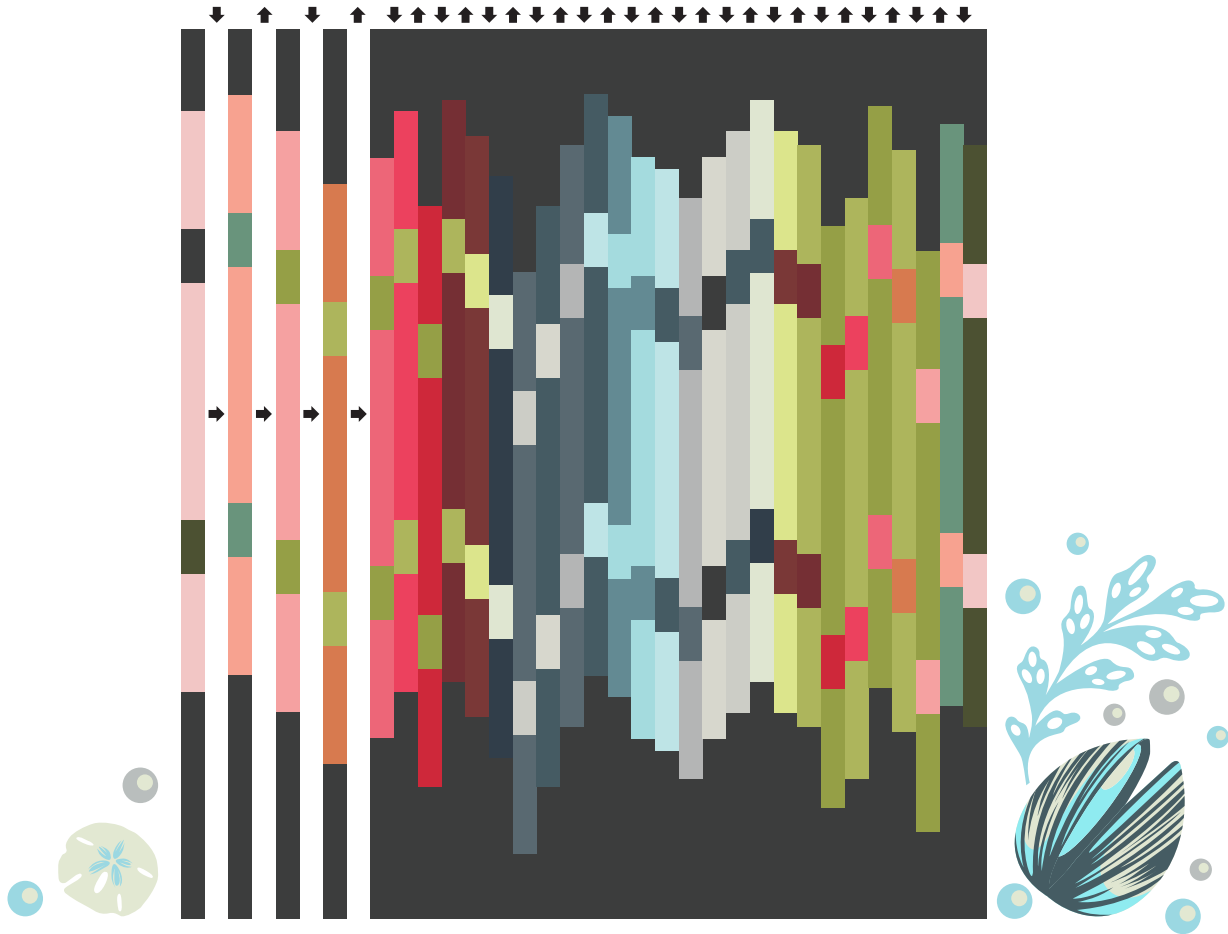
9. Cut each tube at random measurements on the BACKGROUND fabric. Be careful not to cut the strip set segment of the tube. This technique will result in your strip set units being distributed in different position with in the background.



## FINISHING THE QUILT TOP:

10. Sew your strip sets together according to the layout diagram below.
11. Alternate the direction you sew each strip according to the arrows. This will ensure a more even top and bottom edge.
12. Your quilt top will now measure approximately 60" x 88"

*\*To expand the quilt top to fit a larger bed size keep in mind that every strip added to the width will enlarge the quilt top by two inches.*



## FINISH YOUR QUILT

13. Cut (8) strips 2½" x Width of Fabric from your binding fabric. Sew together end to end to create one long strip. Fold the length of the strip in half and press. Set aside for binding.
14. Layer your quilt top, batting and backing.
15. Quilt and Bind.
